PROCEDURE 09: SAFE ENVIRONMENT

Rationale

The school environment should be a safe place for all those who visit and use it. All persons within the school's boundaries are expected to show and accept self-responsibility.

Guidelines

- 1. Safe behaviour is taught at all year levels.
- 2. Presumptions about children's knowledge should not be made.
- 3. All school personnel are always expected to model and promote safe behaviour.
- 4. Should a member of staff identify a risk or hazard, it is incumbent on them to record and report their finding to the principal; the principal will respond according to the Board's Delegation Schedule.
- 5. Emergency procedures must be taught and practiced regularly by all staff and students, with oversight by the Whareorino School Principal.

6. Playground

- a. Regular checks of playground and equipment maintained.
- b. Hazards Register maintained and up to date; Principal reports to School Board on property matters, including identified risks.
- c. Designated play areas should be allocated for specific activities: athletics, marbles etc.
- d. Duty Staff roster maintained.
- e. Safe routines and actions for use of playground equipment.

7. Class

- a. Staff to design all learning programmes with safety of children and staff as paramount.
- b. All equipment, furniture and fittings be maintained and used to the appropriate safety standards.
- c. Children are taught correct methods of using all equipment, appliances and materials and ingredients.
- d. Indoor behaviour is directed with safety in mind.

8. Medical

- a. Pupils with special medical conditions are identified and made known to staff.
- b. Medical precautions are adhered.
- c. All medical supplies are stored in a safe manner.
- d. Harmful supplies are locked away.
- e. Experts to be consulted as necessary.
- f. Teacher development on a regular basis, e.g. First Aid

9. Outdoor Education and Sport

- a. Refer to policy, procedures on Education Outside the Classroom.
- b. Safe practices outside school to be taught, e.g. Road Safety, Water Safety, Farm Safety etc.

10. Equipment and Appliances

- a. Suitable storage of all potentially dangerous equipment and substances.
- b. Regular testing of portable electrical equipment as required to comply with regulations.
- c. Safe practices in school grounds during parent / community gatherings.
